Bedside nurse: The nurse can work in hospital, nursing homes, clinics providing nursing care to the patient and counseling to the family. She/He can specialize in various fields of nursing like operation theater, Liver Transplant, Renal Transplant, Mental Health set up, Geriatric Care, Obstetrics and Gynecology department, orthopedics, etc.

Community health nurse: The nurse can provide valuable service to the community as a Public Health Nurse, participating in various health services of the government. Preventive, curative rehabilitative as well as referral services fall under the scope of nursing. The Public Health Nurse plays a crucial role in delivering government and NGO services to the public forming a bridge between the organization and the people.

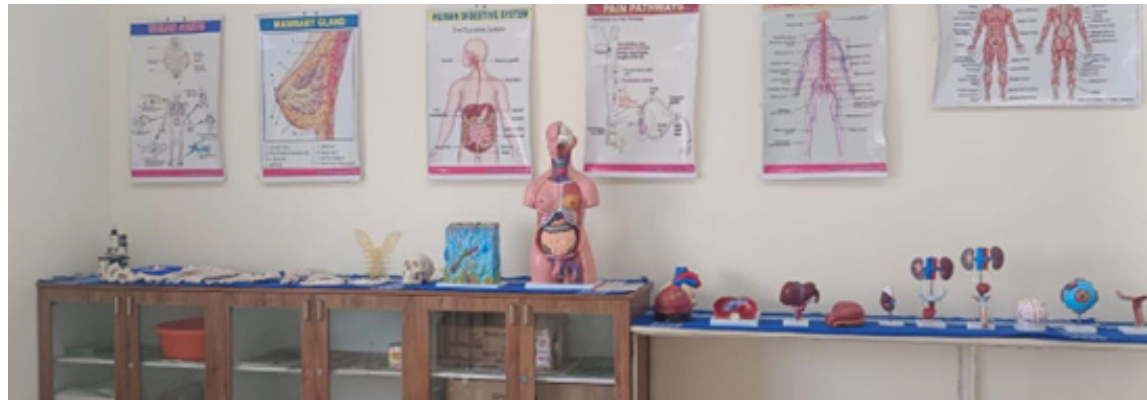

THEORY ASPECTS:

All the Teachers are well qualified with Masters degree in their speciality and highly Experienced persons. They will encourage the students in the Theory aspects as well as the practical and Motivate the students to participate in Extra curricular activities and research activities. They guide the students for their career opportunities.

Etiqueties In The Clinical Area

- Students are strictly **forbidden from accepting gift, cash or any material from the patient or their relatives**. They should not borrow books, or anything from the patients or from their relatives or use their mobile phone.

- Students should wear their uniform neatly **jewellery of any kind, flowers, nail polish etc. are not allowed** during duty hours. Small earring and simple chain may be used. Cut short the nails, ear studs should be without hanging. Hair should be neatly groomed tied up with clip.
- They should **carry all the pocket articles** every day. Shawls are not allowed in the ward black sweaters can be used.
- Professional **dignity, dedication and sincerity** are essential on duty.
- **Avoid holding hands together, giggling and chitchatting sitting in the wards** and reading respect senior staff nurses, doctors and all health care team members,
- Complete the demonstrations and assignment on time.
- Personal calls on hospital **telephones and intercoms are strictly prohibited relatives and friends are not allowed to visit them in the wards and during duty hours.**
- They should not take any assistance from patients, their relatives or the employees of the institution (hospital, college of nursing or hospital) for getting any of their personal work like ticket booking etc.
- Follow **7 rights** before administering medication.
- Accurate **maintenance of records** is very important responsibility.
- Strictly avoid accidents by **negligence** (bedsores,
- Administering wrong medication). Necessary action will be taken against offenders.
- Students have maintain **good interpersonal relationship** with the ward personnel. They have to report to the ward in charge when reaching and leaving the ward. They will give a report of their patients to the ward staff.
- **Dignified behaviour is expected** at all times in clinical area. Watching TV, chatting, standing around, sitting in the nurses station and in patients beds are strictly prohibited.
- **Taking or administering any harmful drug, not authorized by competent authority is strictly prohibited.** In order to curb such tendencies among the students, any student found in possession of any prescribed drug will be summarily dismissed.

Placement Cell and Career Counseling

100% placement assistance is ensured before the completion of final year nursing program through in-house placement and campus interviews. PROCEDURE FOR COUNSELLING:

Selection of the candidates will be based on the marks obtained in the last qualifying examination

ELIGIBILITY FOR B.Sc. NURSING-4 years including internship

- The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.
- The maximum age for admission shall be 35 years.
- Candidates should have passed in the subjects of physics, chemistry, biology (botany and zoology) (PCB) and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 45% marks taken together in PCB at the qualifying examination. I.e., (+2) from the recognized board.
- For the candidates belonging to SC/ST or other backward classes (OBC), the marks obtained in PCB taken together in qualifying examination shall be 40%.
- Student shall be medically fit.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- ◆ H.S.C or equivalent examination mark sheet issued by board of secondary education or equivalent board
- ◆ 10th mark sheet.
- ◆ Conduct character certificate issued by the head of the Institution last studied.
- ◆ Transfer certificate.
- ◆ Community certificate for SC/ST/OBC candidates .
- ◆ Migration certificate (if applicable).
- ◆ Certificate of extra curricular activities.
- ◆ Aadhaar card
- ◆ Pan card
- ◆ First graduate certificate
- ◆ Aadhar card of parents
- ◆ Family Income certificate
- ◆ Medical fitness certificate (original) from the civil surgeon.
- ◆ Hepatitis B vaccination certificate
- ◆ The selected candidates are required to sign a letter of acceptance and submit the original certificates and pay 50% of the fees.

FEES PAYMENTS

Annual fees to be paid within 1 month of Starting the Academic year. If the Fees not Paid the Hall Ticket will not be issued during the Examination.

THE FEES PAID ONCE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES

- ❖ Payment of fees should be made by a crossed demand draft, in favour of CHENNAIS AMIRTA nursing college Chengalpattu.
- ❖ The institution does not accept any donation and has not appointed any agency for this work. In the event of any such offer or payment made to any individual / agencies, the institution will not take the responsibility.
- ❖ The fees once paid are not refundable in any circumstances. No request for their refund will be entertained.
- ❖ MESS FEES TO BE PAID EVERY 6 MONTHS WITHOUT FAIL

LEAVE RULES

- ❖ Student will have 30 days annual leave and 10 days of public holidays.
- ❖ Special leave will be granted in case of serious illness or deceased of parent and sibling only or marriages of siblings only. The genuineness of the ground for leave must be certified to the satisfaction of the management. The special 3 days leave will be deducted from the annual leave.
- ❖ Leaves taken without prior permission will have to be made up at a ratio of 1:2
- ❖ Leaves have to be replaced or made up during vacation or public holidays.
- ❖ Student must have 100% attendance both in clinical and theory in order to take examination.
- ❖ In case of ill health leave letter should be submitted to the principal immediately with medical certificate.
- ❖ Illness of any kind should be reported to the principal in charge. Inmates are not permitted to make private arrangement for medical treatment without the permission. Self medication of any kind is strictly forbidden and if such instance are noticed **SERIOUS ACTION WILL BE TAKEN AGAINST THOSE INVOLVED AND** institution is not responsible if any reaction occurs or anything happens.

RAGGING

- ✓ Ragging is strictly prohibited in the college or hostel premises. Student (freshers) are expected to inform the warden class coordinator in case of such occurrences.
- ✓ If any incident of ragging comes to the notices of authority, the concerned student shall be given the liberty to explain and if her explanation is not found satisfactory the authority would expel her from the institution.

ISSUE OF ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES

- Once the required certificates are submitted to the institution, it will not be return to the student till the receipt of the university certificate after completion of the course. You are encouraged to make xerox attested copies of the same before submission.

INTERNAL ASSESSMENT

- ❖ Internal assessment will be conducted periodically, any student absent for the same without a valid reason will be considered absent. The policy regarding the evaluation as recommended by the statutory body will be followed.

UNIFORM

The students should attend the college with prescribed uniform of the institution. Besides being clean it should be own with decorum to the college, hospital and community.



HEALTH PROGRAMME

Is available to all student decides to discontinue voluntary from the college before completing the course. She should pay back the amount to the institution for the remaining years.

MEMBERSHIP : SNA/TNAI

All student are required to become active members of the student nurses association (SNA), students are expected additionally to become active member of the SNA and TNAI. They have the opportunity to participate in the conferences and competition at state and national level.
